# LIBRARY CORNER

## NEW BOOKS IN THE LIBRARY:

### Good & Angry

Who does not struggle with anger? Is it a serious problem for you? In *Good & Angry: Redeeming anger, irritation, complaining, and bitterness*, David Powlison (executive director of CCEF and a counselor) gives very practical help for all of us. He presents a thorough understanding of anger from a biblical perspective, reflects on the nature of God's anger, and shows us how our anger can "increasingly reflect the loving purposes of God in Christ." This is a book that is helpful for every last one of us in dealing with anger, whether in ourselves or in others. It shows us how to respond in situations that are "not right" and thus anger us. How can we express the right kind of anger? Powlison gives us biblical and practical help. 246 p. Highly recommended. Includes questions at the end of each chapter.

### Wise Up

A new family devotional book is *Wise Up: 10-minute family devotions in Proverbs*, by Marty Machowski. "Christian parents know that good morals aren't enough. Kids need gospel power to 'wise up.'" This is an easy-to-use, 10-minute family devotional exploring Proverbs through a gospel lens, not a moralistic one. Features Bible readings, discussion questions, fun activities, and songs for first- through sixth-grade kids" (from back cover). This devotional is divided into 12 weeks, with 5 devotions/readings per week.

### Devoted to God

Sinclair Ferguson's *Devoted to God; blueprints for sanctification*" provides an orderly exposition of central New Testament passages on holiness." It "builds a strong and reliable structural framework for practical Christian living. It stresses the foundational importance of fundamental issues such as union with Christ, the rhythms of spiritual growth, the reality of spiritual conflict, and the role of God's law." (back cover). 277 p.
